August in Review

August was a
'Great' month, with sales increase
back in the double digits. Looks
like Repair and Restoration parts
sales are the reason, but we had
strong support from our
Commercial customers as well.

33 consecutive months with 'Positive' numbers, increased sales over the previous month/year.

2013 is on track for a 20-30% increase over 2012.

Inventory Changes

CPAZ is working towards our 'significant' change in inventory for 2013. As we are able to obtain 'accessory' parts in 3-5 days, and that segment has slowed considerably, it makes no practical sense to inventory them in quantity. While we will continue to maintain our stock of basic items like car covers, floor mats, etc., this is not where the majority of our sales are generated. We will make a major expansion in what has been the core of our business, restoration and repair parts.

Brakes, Steering column parts, electronic parts, headlight repair parts, chassis and suspension, as well as driveline, clutch and transmission parts. Exhaust systems, radiators, as well as wheels and tires have shown a huge increase and these will be stocked in larger quantities as well. With our new POS system, we hope to have a catalog available sometime this year.

Keep in mind, while we sell 'significantly' more warranties for vehicles other than Corvettes, our warranty company does 'not' have plans available for Corvette Z06 or ZR1 models.

We are sure, the event dates will be correct from now on!!



Bads Bits

One thing we run into, from time to time, is the importance of finding the right service or repair facility to work on your Corvette. While this is very important, dealing with minor repairs, it is 'extremely' important for major repairs or 'Restorations'.

Corvette Arizona has a 'very' short list of Service and Repair facilities we recommend, as we cannot have our customers dissatisfied with a shop that was referred by us.

Two examples came to the forefront in the past week or so.

First, a Corvette radio we sold to a customer, (after months of struggle with 'backorders') was sent to a 'restorer' in Tucson. While the radio was designed for the Corvette, it was also a new design, that added the new features of MP3, USB and the ability to add a remote CD Changer. It included the radio 'and' a custom

plate that enabled the radio to fit the Corvette dash. Seems the installer could not figure out the installation and the customer returned the radio (one if only 6 returns we have had in our first 3 1/2 years).

Question: If a 'Corvette Restoration' shop cannot install a radio (with the instructions), how can you justify the months/dollars they are charging for the 'Restoration!?

Second, 'Preferred Customer' comes in and buys 'Ceramic' Brake Pads for his Corvette Grand Sport. As the GS shares the brakes from a Z06, it is a straight forward install, replacing the 6 'pucks' from the Z06, with the one piece Ceramic Pads.

In the past 120 days, we have sold 47 sets of these brake pads with 'no' problems with the installation. While they increase braking capability, the primary reason most of our customers buy them is 'significant' reduction in brake dust and cleaner wheels.

This customer takes his Corvette to a GM dealership who informs him, they are not the right pads and they will not install them.

My response, "Tell the Service Tech to go *F* himself!!", was wrong and out of line.

What I should have said was:

- (A) Does the dealership not allow customers to bring their own parts?
- (B) Is it the Tech's first day on the job?
- (C) Does the dealership not work on many Corvettes and is Customer Service not important to them?

I called the dealership Service Manager, found that they were not familiar with Ceramic Pads, and 'preferred' to use GM parts 'only'! The customer took his Corvette to a 'qualified' Corvette mechanic, and his Corvette was done and back on the road promptly.

The point is.....Make sure your mechanic, restoration shop or repair facility is, not only 'familiar' with Corvettes, but has the experience, equipment and tools to work on your Corvette.

As always, we will support American products whenever and where ever possible.
